**NOTICE OF MOTION**

---

**MEMBER FOR DENISON:** I give notice that on the next day of sitting I shall move—That this House:

1. acknowledges that the 43<sup>rd</sup> Parliament agreed to the Motion introduced by the Member for Denison that contained statements that the then Members of the House:
  - a. acknowledge the large number of mothers and fathers with serious grievances with family law and the child support system;
  - b. note that there has not been a comprehensive review of the child support system since the *In the Best Interests of Children - Reforming the Child Support Scheme* review in 2005;
  - c. call on the Government to undertake a comprehensive review of family law and the child support system; and
  - d. recommend that the Terms of Reference of this review be formulated to ensure that the safety and wellbeing of children is paramount;
2. further acknowledges a review never took place;
3. notes that, despite the Minister for Social Services requesting an inquiry into the Child Support Program during the 44<sup>th</sup> Parliament, it is not an holistic and detailed review of both child support and family law; and
4. calls on the Government to honour the will of the 43<sup>rd</sup> Parliament and commission a comprehensive root and branch review of family law and the Child Support Program with sufficient mandate to effectively consider the interaction between these systems.
